These fees are designed to cover all tuition expenses for all students, with some exceptions, set out below. The fees include such expenses as camps, music programs (class lessons and band training), retreats/reflection days, College publications as well as the usual administrative, curriculum, sport and staffing costs.

The Family Capital Development Levy is used to support development and major renovation programs. This is not a voluntary levy.

Please note the following are not within the inclusive fee:

- Year 10 optional camps
- Private music tuition and instrument hire
- Annual music camp
- Elective LOTE study tours
- Yaluwo Immersion (Year 12)
- Year 12 Valedictory Dinner
- Papua New Guinea Immersion (Year 11)
- Wilcannia Immersion

#### VET/VCAL students

A fee will be imposed if a student withdraws from a VET or VCAL unit during the year or where the subject levy for the VET/VCAL unit exceeds \$3,000.

#### Music

Private music lessons are available as an option to students and are charged separately from school fees; the charges are \$715 per Semester (16 x 30 minute lessons). Limited instrument hire is also available.

#### Technology Levy

Students will be charged an annual technology levy to cover the cost of a notebook and supporting services.

## Advance Fee Payment

Students commencing at the College in 2017 or later are required to pay an advance fee. This fee will be held and deducted from the fees payable in the last year the student is at the College.

For students commencing in 2019, the fee will be \$4,380. For students commencing in 2020, the fee will be \$4,660. The advance fee payment is payable in 3 instalments.

A component of this fee is non-refundable, should the student elect not to commence at the College.

## Payment of Fees

Fees are payable by one of the following methods:

- In full by end of February;
- In three equal instalments one each at the end of February, May and August;
- In ten equal instalments- payable each month from February to November inclusive; or
- Other regular payments by arrangement with the Director of Finance & Administration.

A late fee of \$120 will be levied for fees not received by the nominated date.

## Discounts

### Family discount

There is a 10% discount on the tuition fees for each student where there is more than one boy from the family attending the College.

### CSEF discount

Families that qualify for the Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF) will receive a discount of \$225. To apply for CSEF funding, complete the form available on the following website:

### Early payment discount

A discount is available for early payment of the full yearly tuition fee and family capital levy:

- \$350 per student for all fees paid in full by 12 December 2017 or
- \$250 per student for all fees paid in full by 28 February 2018.

## Refund Policy

One term's notice, in advance, in writing, is required if the student is being withdrawn from the College. Fees are payable up to and including the notice term. Fees already paid are refunded for any part of the year remaining after the term's notice period.
