PBS 106.7FM Announcer Training

Students often ask about how to become a radio announcer! The **PBS Announcer** short training course gives students the basic skills to plan and put together a radio program of broadcast quality. Sessions are practical and include: *writing for radio, interviewing skills, broadcast law, and technical skills and planning a program*. On completion of the course, students submit a demo for assessment, which may also be used to apply for a radio show on PBS.

Each short course runs for five consecutive evenings from 6.30pm – 9.00pm; at the PBS studios in Collingwood, and the 2012 Course Schedule for the remainder of the year is as follows:

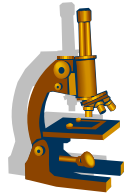

Career as a Bricklayer

Qualified bricklayer craftspeople are in short supply. The bricklayer population mix is highly skewed to experienced but older age tradespeople, rapidly retiring from the industry. Demand for brick building remains strong.

Bricks are a highly sustainable building material due to their thermal properties and relatively lower fossil fuel energy consumption compared to timber and steel, so bricks are therefore likely to become even more popular as a building material into the future. Australia will need a steady flow of qualified craftspeople to supply and lead the industry.
