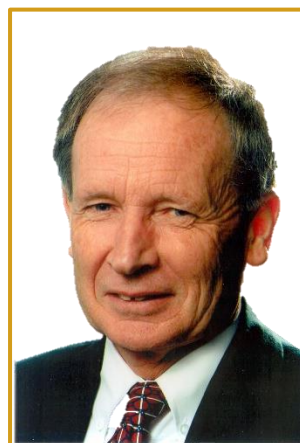
MARK PARKER
